The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the State Route 132 (SR 132) West Project City of Oakdale

progress update.

City of Patterson

The Stanislaus Council of Governments (StanCOG), in cooperation with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to develop and construct State Route 132 (SR 132) West Project in phases. Currently one of the proposed phases is to extend the recently opened two-lane SR 132 expressway/freeway from Gates Road/Paradise Road to

Dakota Avenue in Stanislaus County.

City of Waterford The project proposes to extend the newly constructed SR 132 from Dakota Ave to Gates

> Road. StanCOG proposes to extend the access-controlled two-lane divided expressway/freeway along an alignment approximately 0.5 mile north of existing SR 132 (Maze Boulevard). On the western end of the project, the alignment would curve to reconnect to existing SR 132 in the vicinity of Gates Ave/Paradise. The project would

include a roundabout at the realigned SR 132/Gates Rd/Paradise Rd intersection. **Policy Board Chair** 

Javier Lopez The project would construct a grade separation at Hart Road crossing over SR 132. North

Dakota Avenue would have an overcrossing at the newly built SR 132 with no access to SR 132. No additional improvements are proposed on North Dakota Avenue between

existing Maze Blvd. and the recently opened two-lane SR 132 expressway/freeway.
